



Job Description: HVAC Service Technician (Journeyman)

JOB REQUIREMENTS

Perform skilled, complex work in the repair, maintenance, and installation of heating, ventilating, and air conditioning equipment and energy management systems. We are a union employer so the successful applicant will be required to become a member of the United Association of Journeymen and Apprentices of the Plumbing and Pipefitting Industry of the United States and Canada (UA Local 41).

Major Duties and Responsibilities:

- Install, maintain, and repair commercial heating, ventilating, and air conditioning equipment systems including natural gas, propane, oil, and electric systems.
- Install, maintain, and repair boiler systems.
- Diagnose mechanical and electronic components for causes of problems and/or failures in systems for the purpose of evaluating condition, identifying necessary repairs, and recommending preventive maintenance.
- Install and/or repair electrical connections to HVAC components.
- Perform routine and preventive maintenance as needed for the purpose of ensuring the ongoing functioning of HVAC systems.
- Conserve, install, and recycle refrigerants.
- Perform brazing, soldering, pipefitting, welding, and fabrication.
- Maintain vehicle, tools, and equipment for the purpose of ensuring availability in safe operating condition.
- Prepare written documentation on field service software mobile app and manage materials (e.g. repair status, activity logs, work orders, estimates, quotes, etc.) for the purpose of documenting activities, conveying information, billing, and bidding.
- Order equipment and supplies from vendors for the purpose of ensuring availability of items required to complete the necessary installation and/or repair.
- Participate in meetings, workshops, training, and seminars as assigned for the purpose of conveying and/or gathering information required to perform job functions.

- Operate a variety of equipment such as hand tools, tablets, and diagnostic and testing instruments to perform work.
- Maintain a safe work environment and comply with OSHA requirements.
- Assist other trades (plumbing, electrical, and controls) as necessary.

Supervisory Responsibilities: None

Minimum Job Requirements:

- Must be able to read complex blueprints, piping, sketches, schematics, and wiring diagrams.
- High school diploma or GED.
- Five years HVAC experience.
- Current Montana driver's license.
- Current Universal EPA Refrigeration Certificate (608 certification).
- Must be able to work with others as part of a team and work with constant interruptions.
- Must display a high level of mechanical aptitude.
- Must present a professional, positive, and helpful attitude always when interacting with customers and co-workers.
- Willingness to travel within the state of Montana with occasional overnight stays.
- Ability to pass background check.
- Attain membership in the United Association of Journeyman and Apprentices of the Plumbing and Pipefitting Industry of the United States and Canada.

Physical Requirements/Working Conditions:

- Moderate physical effort requiring prolonged periods of standing, bending, kneeling, crouching, stooping, and crawling.
- Periodic lifting, carrying, pushing, and pulling of heavy items.
- Routine discomfort from exposure to moderate levels of heat, cold, moisture, and air pollution.
- Work environment will include roofs (flat and sloping), basements, crawl spaces, attics, and mechanical rooms.
- Some jobs may require work on high structures such as ladders, lifts, and scaffolds.

BENEFITS
